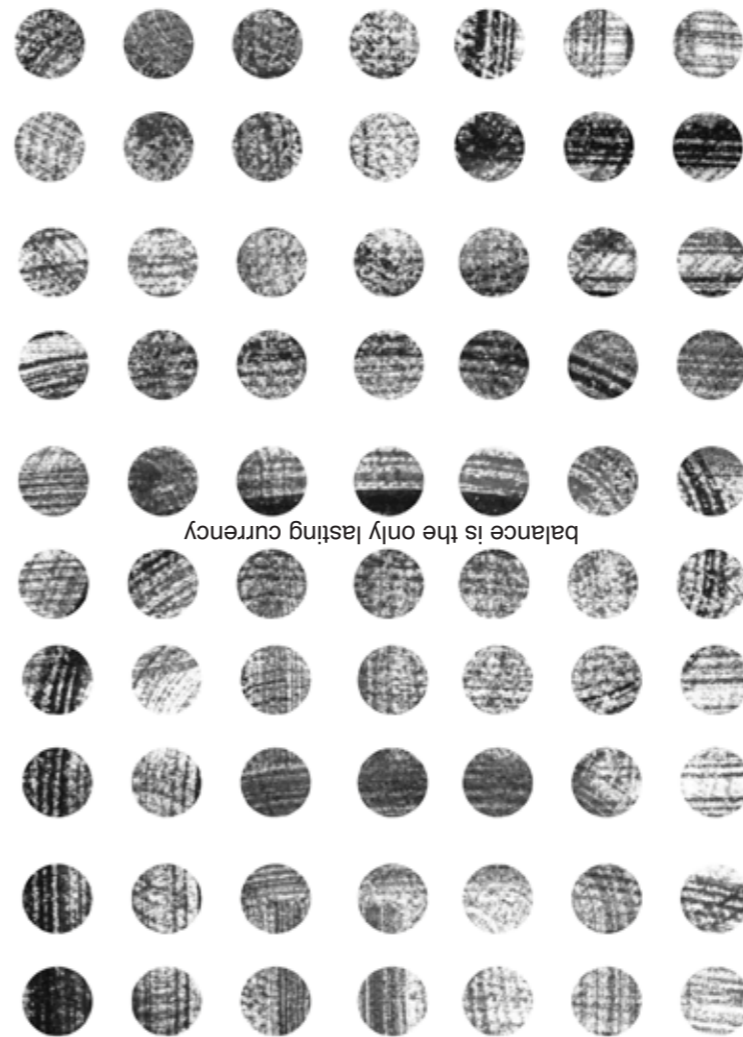


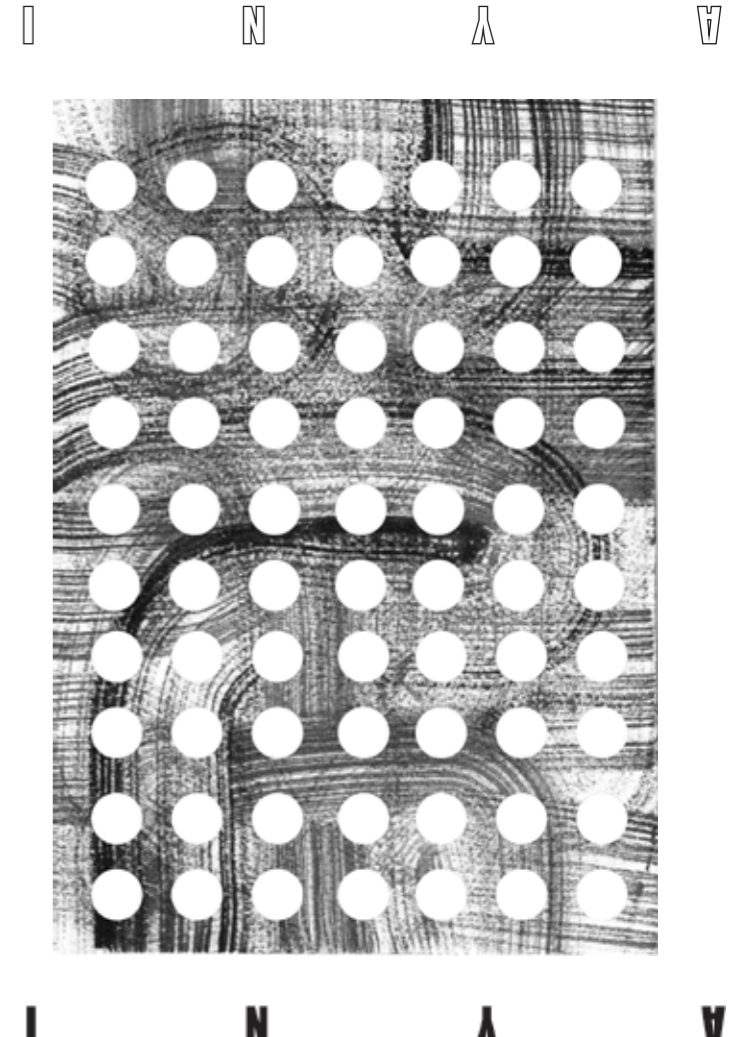

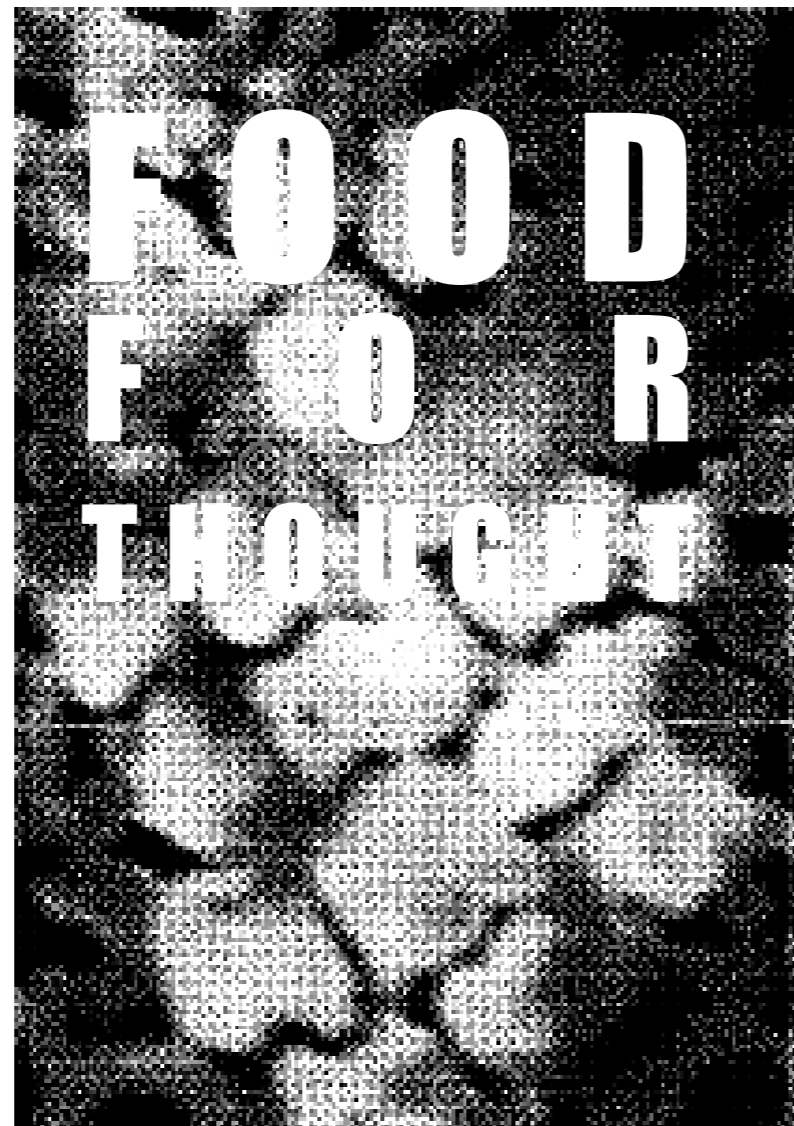

Ayninakuy



Ayninakuy is deeply rooted in Quechua culture, where reciprocity (Ayni) is a core value shaping social and economic life. In the Andean worldview, cooperation ensures the survival and well-being of the community, reinforcing the interconnected relationship between people, nature, and Pachamama (Mother Earth). This principle has sustained Quechua societies for centuries, fostering resilience through shared labor, collective rituals, and communal resource management.
